NOOSA TOUCH ASSOCIATION RULES

- 1. This is a Senior Competition all players must be AT LEAST 13 years of age within the calendar year to participate.
- 2. All team players have to register online every new season to every team to qualify to play in any Noosa touch competitions, your delegate or manager has your team code so then you can register on the Noosa touch website in online registrations. A player must be registered by round 4 and sign on for 5 registered games during a season to qualify for the finals. This 5 week duration will not start until players are registered and printed on the card. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS
- 3. Teams must nominate a duty referee who will be available before or after their game. New teams have the ability to pay a fee to the club to supply a referee for the first 2 seasons only
- 4. Mixed, Men's and Ladies Teams who play at 6pm will duty ref at 7pm. Teams playing at 7pm will referee at 6pm. Teams who play at 8pm will not have a duty. The duty ref system can change from season to season depending on the amount, of teams entered.
 - If the nominated referee does not turn up to referee, nor has the referee organised another referee to replace them, then the Team will be penalized according to the penalty referee system.
- 5. Mixed and Men's players can play only in two teams during round games only, if the game times clash you can play one game only. You can't play in two teams at the same time in one night or in any final matches.
- 6. The team competitors must agree and abide by the guidelines and bylaws as set by the Noosa Touch Association Inc.
- 7. Interrupted games rules, 1st half game declared void, 2nd half score will stand.
- 8. Teams who forfeit after midday on their nominated match day may be deducted 3 points.

The Association is primarily an Association of affiliated Clubs / Teams. Clubs / Teams admitted to affiliation with the Association shall be bound by the Constitution of the Association and the bylaws determined from time to time by the Management Committee of the Association. A copy of the Constitution of the Association is available upon request. Clubs / Teams shall not be admitted to affiliation with the Association until the Association accepts and receives their registration / insurance form, and payment of affiliation fees.

Until Clubs / teams are affiliated with the Association (nomination accepted by the Association and affiliation fees received), such Clubs / Teams are not covered by insurance maintained by and for the benefit of the Association and Clubs / Teams affiliated with the Association.

The Team delegate (Contact person on Nomination Form) agrees to be solely responsible for all nomination and related fees payable for the season by the Club / Team he or she represents.

TEAM DELEGATE DECLARATION:

I acknowledge that I'll read the Conditions of Entry for nomination and agree to accept those conditions on behalf of the team I represent. I declare that my team agree to all times abide by the byaws of the Association and will accept all decisions made by the Noosa Touch Association Management Committee as final.

I also understand that I am fully responsible for ensuring that all players in my team are correctly registered as Members of Noosa Touch Association for the Season.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & BYLAWS

Team Nominations cut off dates will be communicated via our FB page and Website or when we have received the maximum number of nominations that we can cater for in each division. We suggest you nominate your team ASAP to avoid the disappointment of missing a place in the Competition, as team numbers can be limited.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE:</u> A condition of our public liability / sports injury insurance policy is that the premium MUST be paid BEFORE our third round is played. Therefore, all teams MUST pay the minimum amount of \$650.00 (before taking the field). There will be NO exceptions, as any team or player who has not paid or registered this amount on time is not covered by insurance, and therefore WILL NOT be on the draw until the amount is paid.

<u>Team Delegate</u>: It is the responsibility of the Team Delegate to relay all relevant information to their players or advise their players how to view our Conditions of Entry and the website.

Wash Outs: If fixtures are washed out, a message will be placed on our website in the NEWS section or on our Noosa touch face book page after 1pm. Due to time constraints, it may be necessary to alter the competition times or days to complete the competition.

Forfeits: WARNING: Three forfeits and you will no longer be in the competition It will be the responsibility of each TEAM DELEGATE to keep a record of individual player payments towards their team fees. It is not the club's responsibility to supply a breakdown of names and amounts.

Code of Conduct: All players, supporters, officials and spectators are bound by our code of behaviour whilst on site within the Noosa complex during Touch fixture nights. Abusive or indecent behaviour will not be tolerated at any time. Any teams, players, officials or spectators found to be acting in any way detrimental to Noosa Touch Association face instant disqualification from the Association. The



Management Committee reserves the right to expel any team or individual, at any time, if such action is deemed to be in the best interests of the Association.

Management: All teams reserve the right to appeal to the Management Committee in regard to any matter concerning their team. Likewise, the Management Committee reserves the right to make any decision regarding the competition, or its participants, that they believe to be in the best interests of the Association.

Game Details: Playing Rules will be as per Touch Football Australia 8th edition Playing Rules, and Noosa Touch Association's Bylaws & Conditions of Entry.

A minimum of **four** players is required to commence a game. If 4 players are not present at the scheduled time of commencement, the team will be given an additional five minutes to field a team before the game is forfeited. All Grades will be six a side, with unlimited interchange.

Mixed Teams: All mixed sides are required to field a 3 female / 3 male formation. In the event of this combination being unavailable, a mixed team must have a minimum of 1 male and 1 female on the field at all times, with a maximum of 3 males allowed on the field at any time. Up to 5 females can take the field at any time, providing at least one male is also on the field.

Nominated Referees

- At the start of each season, the team nominates a person/s who will be the nominated referee for that team (excluding new team entrants as per NTA Rule #3 outlined above)
- The team is required to put down a \$100.00 bond which is the first payment upon nomination of the team.
- For each game the nominated referee does not turn up on their allocated game time, there will be a penalty fine deduction from the teams \$100.00. If your nominated referee is unable to be at the game, you may replace them with another referee. There will be no deduction of money where you have a replacement for the night.
- When a team has missed their 1st duty by not fulfilling their referee duties, a \$50 fine will apply, 2nd time will be a \$100 fine, 3nd time will be \$150 etc, and the team will not be in the draw until this has been paid.
- At the end of the season, each team will be refunded their bond or can chose to have it rolled over into the following season. A \$100 bond must be held by the club to be in the draw.
- <u>Mixed, Men's and Ladies Teams</u> who play at 6pm will duty ref at 7pm. Teams playing at 7pm will referee at 6pm. Teams who play at 8pm will not have a duty. The duty ref system can change from season to season depending on the amount, of teams entered.
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- Teams are required to sign their duty referee sheet at the referee's room before the start of their game. Teams who have not signed on their duty referee will not be able to start the commencement of their game until this has been done.

On the completion of the competition, the full or part of the bond is refunded to the team. (Full bond if all allocated games have been attended by your nominated referee or part if the club has taken payment where your referee has not shown).



Uniform Policy: All players must be in individually numbered identical shirts, along with shorts, No PINK or WHITE shirts will be acceptable, as these colours are predominately used by referees to officiate the games. Your team must be in uniform by week 4. Players out of uniform will be asked to leave the field and not play unless they have a uniform or have submitted a letter to the committee, and it has been passed by the committee.

Numbers must be either on both sleeves (8cm), or on the back of the shirt (16cm). Short pullovers / jumpers may be worn UNDER the playing shirt. Please note that the Administration staff CANNOT and WILL NOT override a Referee's decision or make a uniform policy decision on behalf of a Referee. No players can play in any finals matches unless they have uniform.

Insurance / Registration. All teams are required to nominate and be registered online before they play. Any new players joining your team MUST first register online for any insurance. This is available on the Noosa touch website under online registration.

All players are required to sign the game card weekly

Any player caught signing on for another player will be immediately disqualified from playing for the remainder of the season, including finals. Any team found breaking this rule will be deemed ineligible to play in the finals. All team players have to register online every new season to every team to qualify to play in any Noosa touch competitions, your delegate or manager has your team code so then you can register on the Noosa touch website in online registrations.

A player must be registered by round 4 and sign on for 5 registered games during a season to qualify for the finals. This will not start until players are registered and printed on the card.
